22.  **Etchart Privado Malbec-Cabernet Sauvignon, Salta, Argentina** £24.95
Full-bodied, combining the spicy, roasted character typical of the Malbec, with the strong blackcurrant flavour of the Cabernet.
23.  **Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France, France** £24.95
From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice.
24.  **Chianti, Ruffino, Italy** £25.95
Harmonious and mellow, with violet and red berry notes on a soft and refreshing finish.
